Located on a 10-acre campus and surrounded by farmland, UHS-Keystone Schools, Elmira is an educational day program, providing specialized services to students in Solano and surrounding counties. The school opened in October 2003 and is licensed by the California Department of Education.

UHS-Keystone Schools, Elmira provides intensive behavioral services as well as individual, group, and family therapy. The school uses "best practices," research-based programs, and positive behavior management to facilitate eventual transition to a public school. A rich variety of academic, social, recreational and pre-vocational experiences helps students develop their own interests and life plans. Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) combined with an intensive behavioral management system ensure a positive learning outcome for each of our students.

The school's highly qualified classroom team includes a Special Education Teacher, Educational Assistant, Mental Health Professional, Speech Pathologist and an Occupational Therapist, who work as a team to develop an educational plan to meet the special needs of each student.

We are committed to admitting and helping *every child*, whatever the challenges a child is seeking to overcome. Finding hope for children who are considered hopeless by others is something we do every day. At UHS-Keystone Schools, Elmira, kids always come first, and we see hope in every child.
