

# Non-Public School for Students With Special Needs

## UHS KEYSTONE SCHOOLS, RANCHO CUCAMONGA

*UHS-Keystone Schools, Rancho Cucamonga* is a non-public community-based school serving grades 1-12. The campus at Rancho Cucamonga features regular academic classes that utilize core curriculum, behavior management and crisis intervention. The school employs a strong instructional program that incorporates “best practices” in instruction and curriculum with a strong behavioral approach that is data driven and success oriented. A year-round program provides continuity of services to increase academic success. The school also provides curb-to-curb transportation.

To optimize each child’s educational experience, the school’s professionally trained staff utilizes an educational program driven by the IEP, which serves as “an educational map.” They also use standards-based education and research-based methodologies, curriculum, and behavioral programs.

Speech Therapy is also provided through the IEP process.

Another highlight of the school’s curriculum is the REACH System, a California State Adopted Intervention Program for students who are below grade level in reading and writing. Rancho Cucamonga’s transition curriculum prepares students for the CAHSEE (California High School Exit Exam). The school also utilizes the TEACCH model for students with autism. Weekly community outings are linked to standards based curriculum. Sports teams include football, basketball and soccer.

- Male and Female, grades 1-12
- Classified per California Education Code as Emotionally Disturbed
- Middle and High School students with autistic-like behaviors and/or significantly below average cognitive ability
- Students placed through district of residence
