The school serves students with emotional and/or significant learning disabilities. The program offers a modified, traditional calendar, including an extended school year. Student's average length of stay is approximately 18-24 months.

UHS-Keystone Schools, Steele Canyon provides each student with an individualized academic and behavioral program. Committed to quality and excellence, UHS-Keystone Schools, Steele Canyon offers a multi-faceted program where all staff treat students with respect and dignity. The school's mission, in collaboration with the residential treatment facility, is to provide a comprehensive academic and behavior program that helps students reach their full

potential, overcome barriers to student achievement, and build upon their success toward life-long learning. Once successfully completing the program, most students are referred back to the public school system and a lesser restrictive residential environment.
