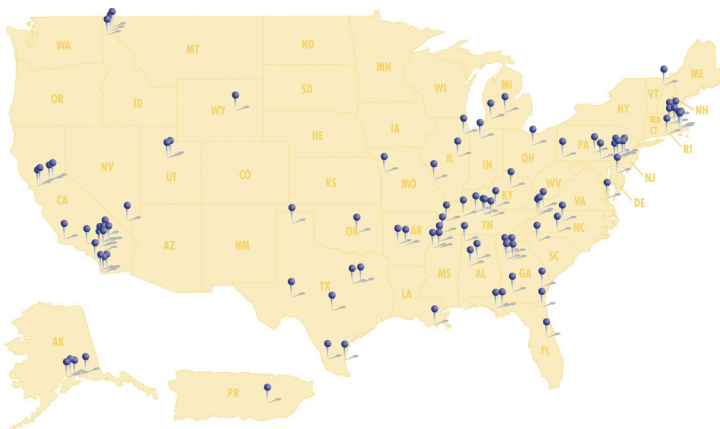

Our Facilities & Operations

The UHS Behavioral Health Division currently operates 70 inpatient treatment facilities in 30 states and San Juan, Puerto Rico.

As a compliment to our Behavioral Health continuum, UHS currently operates a Wilderness Program, three Therapeutic Boarding Schools and one Emotional Growth Boarding School with residential components. Additionally, our 19 Nonpublic Schools (NPS's) work with students with special needs. Our NPS's serve students with developmental disabilities ranging from the emotionally disturbed to autistic. Ages range from 5 through 22.

UHS also operates 6 facilities that serve the Juvenile Detention System in their respective markets.



Our Organizational Structure

Operations are coordinated by Regional Vice Presidents, who report directly to the Division President. All of the facilities are supported by a corporate-based team that includes clinicians, senior behavior analysts, quality assurance and risk management staff, financial experts, human resources professionals, credential analysts, curriculum and instruction specialists, educational accountability staff, marketing and business development experts, and an information and technology department.
